



Ways you can help with Children's ministries:

PRAY! Pray for the teachers and the kids, that they would be diligent in learning.

Sunday School Leader: Guides children through the lesson and activity, using a prepared curriculum. Teaches the same lesson (with age appropriate modifications) to three different age groups over 4 weeks. Pastor Mike has the materials set up when you arrive. Usually involves three out of four Sundays of a rotation (4 weeks). Some prep helpful.

Sunday School Shepherd: Stays with the same group of children over the course of a rotation (usually four weeks), helping the leader with the activity and helping the kids pay attention. Easy and fun! No prep required.

Sunday School Greeter: Helps direct child and parent newcomers to the appropriate Sunday school class. Can attend an adult class after greeting.

Little Lambs (2-3 yr olds): This preschool curriculum includes a Bible story and simple craft. Very little prep required. Ideally we have teams of 2 people who alternate months.

Children's church: During worship, after the time with young disciples, children aged 4-1st grade are invited to a worship experience geared to their age. They learn about the basic elements of worship, such as singing, the offering and listening to the Bible story. Then they do a simple craft to reinforce the lesson. Teams of 2 people are assigned each week.

Nursery: Each week an adult or older youth volunteer assists our staff nursery attendant during worship and Sunday School

Worship Bags: This individual makes sure the worship bags are refilled and made ready for the next worship service.

Drive/ride the Bus: We reach out to areas where kids do not have reliable transportation. We are working on a regular schedule to get these kids to worship and church events.

Music programs: Our Wednesday Children's music program begins at 5:30 with a meal each week. Volunteers are needed to provide a meal.
